

# PLAY DOUGH RECIPES

## COLORED PLAY DOUGH

1 cup water  
1 tablespoon vegetable oil  
1/2 cup salt  
1 tablespoon cream of tartar  
food coloring  
1 cup flour

Combine water, oil, salt, cream of tartar, and food coloring in a saucepan and heat until warm. Remove from heat and add flour. Stir, then knead until smooth. Store this dough in an airtight container or a Ziploc freezer bag.

## SALT DOUGH

1 cup salt  
1 cup water  
1/2 cup flour

Mix salt, water, and flour in saucepan and cook over medium heat. Remove from heat when mixture is thick and rubbery. As the mixture cools, knead in enough flour to make the dough workable.

## BASIC UNCOOKED PLAY DOUGH

1 cup cold water  
1 cup salt  
2 teaspoons vegetable oil  
tempera paint or food coloring  
3 cups flour  
2 tablespoons cornstarch

In bowl, mix water, salt, oil, and enough tempera paint or food coloring to make a bright color. Gradually add flour and cornstarch until the mixture reaches the consistency of bread dough. Store covered.
